In all instances, unless specifically stated, the date is the date of burial, not that of death. Taking into consideration the consecutive numbers, which commence in 1831 and continue on until 1830, the following records do not seem to have been made as the burials took place, but after 1831 they are regular, if somewhat meagre. In 1834 there are only three recorded deaths, two being those of children. Furthermore, in the case of children, an occupation is shown: this is apparently the occupation of the father.

ROMAN CATHOLIC RECORDS (Incomplete)

The following records are contained in two registers in possession of St Patricks Church, Fremantle, the first bearing the date 1851, but the opening entry therein being No. 1, 9th March, 1852. This register is carried on consecutively until May 1874, when the last few entries become disjointed. Thereafter, although there are many unused pages in the book, no further registrations of deaths appear to have been made until another register comes in to being on the 9th August, 1887, and which Brings the records beyond 1900.

No earlier records than those of 1852 seem to be extant, although Fr. T. Donovan who makes the first entries was definitely in charge at Fremantle as early as June, 1851, and possibly beforethat, being the first priest ordained in Western Australia by Bishop Brady who came out with Bishop Savaldo in 1846, although the latter at that time had not been elevated to a bishopric. Fr. Brady had arrived at Fremantle on his first visit on the 8th December, 1843, and it is from that date, therefore, that the establishment of the Roman Catholic Church in the Colony takes place. With regard to burials, the first nine years are unaccounted for, and there is a further blank of thirteen years later on.

The records are wholly in Latin, and errors in the following translation may have crept in, although every care has been taken to ensure accuracy.

Several of the earliest burials recorded are stated to have taken place in the Protestant Cemetery, which evidently refers to Alma St. which was originally vested in the Church of England. The other interments took place in St. Patricks Cemetery or the Catholic Cemetery, situated at Skinner St. Later burials are shown to have been made at the New St. Patrick's Cemetery, near Fremantle, i.e. at Carrington St.
